Call for Papers

The Lighthouse invites submissions of papers on original, substantial, and unpublished research in all aspects of disability and veterans' law for its inaugural issue. *The Lighthouse* accepts manuscript submissions from military and civilian authors. Any work submitted for publication will be evaluated by *The Lighthouse*'s Editorial Board.

We are open to manuscripts of any length; book reviews of timely and relevant publication are also accepted. We encourage authors to write articles in language accessible to both legal professionals and thoughtful non-experts. Submissions that minimize legal, medical, and military jargon are especially encouraged. *The Lighthouse* does not review or publish content that has previously been published elsewhere. Please submit original content.

Each submission will be reviewed internally and externally—internally by at least one editorial board member and, if the submission is found suitable, then externally via a peer review process. In determining whether to publish a work, the Board considers the work in light of *The Lighthouse*'s mission and evaluates the work's argument, research, and style. Submissions will be judged on clarity, originality, meaningful comparison, and contributions to legal and policy research resources. If accepted, manuscripts will be edited and returned to the author for review. We will make every effort to clear any changes with the author.

Citations should appear as endnotes, and all citations should conform to the most recent edition of *The Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation*. Citations should identify sources completely and accurately. Lengthy textual commentary and string cites are discouraged.

Please include a short sentence or two describing your professional affiliation, background and any area(s) of professional specialization. This description will appear with the article if it is accepted for publication. Please also include a phone number and postal mail address.

Deadline: Please submit your manuscript and a short (50 word) abstract no later than December 31st, 2021.
